

This list includes all the items your son will need during his time at Woodcote; please keep it safe as you will need to refer to it at the beginning of each term. Please read the following notes and do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.

SCHOOL SHOP

We have an excellent shop, run by Lucy Monk (email shop@woodcotehouseschool.co.uk), and all items in the first column on the attached list can be purchased from the shop, new or second hand. The shop is open before the start of each term and on Wednesday afternoons during term time. Appointments can be made at other times with prior arrangement.

SHOES

All shoes must be in good repair and permanently marked with the boys' school number (3rd Form/ Year 5 upwards) or initials, if he is a Junior/Years 3 & 4. Please ensure shoes are cleaned and polished on return from Exeats, Half Term and at the start of each Term.

CLOTHES

All clothes must be in good repair and clearly marked with name tapes (small size) showing the boys' full name. It is not necessary to have the school number on tapes. Please try clothes on before term starts. All new full boarders should order three dozen sew-on name tapes to label all school uniform and home clothes. Please DO NOT USE iron-on name tapes or write names in permanent marker. Games clothes name tapes (large size) need to be purchased from www.wovenlabelsuk.com. They are listed as ID Tags and must be ordered as 1 inch in size, red text with a white background colour and should be ordered with surname first followed by first name. For example MONK WILLIAM.

Please note for all new boys, whose parents live overseas, name tapes for uniform and games kit will be ordered on their behalf before the start of term. However, it is important that all home clothes and personal belongings are labelled before arriving at school.

We provide green string bags for all games kit. Tape loops must be sewn on all towels (long side please), flannels, sweaters and games clothes. For info, IKEA sell towels with hooks already sewn in.

NB: DAY BOYS All games kit will be sent home in the string bags at weekends for washing. Clean kit to be brought back in on a Monday morning. Please ensure green string bags are also named.

SMART CLOTHES

When boys visit Senior Schools for interviews and assessments, they are provided with a white shirt, grey pullover and tweed blazer. These items are lent to boys and should be returned clean to school after the interview or assessment.

UNIFORM LABELLING

Please ensure <u>all</u> uniform is labelled properly and correctly

For everyday uniform, small nametapes should be sewn on the inside of each garment. A tape hook for the Brown V-Neck Sweaters is also required so that they can be hung up on their individual pegs when not being worn.

LARGE NAME TAPE POSITIONING FOR GAMES KIT

Labels to be sewn on the **INSIDE**

Brown/Gold games shorts – inside back of waistband.

Brown/Gold reversible games shirt – inside back of collar.

Tracksuit bottoms – inside back of waistband.

Tracksuit top – inside back of collar.

Gold baselayer – inside back of collar.

White cricket sun hat - inside back of crown

White polo shirt – inside back of collar.

TOWELS

Please use a LARGE NAME TAPE as per the Games Kit, for each towel. Sew midway down one of the LONG SIDES of the towel. A tape hook is also required in the same place.

All other items, including personal belongings and home clothes must also be labelled with the smaller name tapes. Shoes/trainers/wellies may be named (school number/initials) using permanent markers, where appropriate.
